INTERPRETERS FOR HEARING-IMPAIRED PARENTS

In compliance with Section 3230 of the Laws of 1992 and Commissioner's Regulations, the Board of Education of the Cobleskill-Richmondville Central School District shall provide, at no charge, to hearing impaired parents or persons in parental relation the services of an interpreter so they can attend school initiated meetings or activities relating to their child's educational program, either academic and/or disciplinary.

To receive the services of an interpreter the parents must make a written request before the meeting or activity.

- a) The request should be made to the Director of Pupil Personnel Services, who makes the arrangements.
- b) This must be made, at least, one week before the meeting and/or activity.
- c) This is available for both in and out of district programs.

The policy provides that if an interpreter can not be found, the parents, will be accommodated through the use of written communication and/or technology.
