

**HIGH SCHOOL GRADE LEVEL PLACEMENT POLICY****Grade 10 (Sophomore)**

Successful completion of English 9, Global History I, one unit of Mathematics or Science, and a minimum of 4.5 credits.

**Grade 11 (Junior)**

Successful completion of English 9 and 10, Global History I and II, a combined total of three units of Mathematics and Science, and a minimum of 10 credits.

**Grade 12 (Senior)**

Scheduled to complete graduation requirements by June or August.

**Implementation**

To be phased in with students entering Grade 9 in September 2002. Students who entered Grade 9 in September 2001 will be recognized as Sophomores but must earn Junior standing by September 1, 2003.

Reminder—students must complete New York State Regents/Competency testing requirements to receive a New York State diploma. Testing requirements are listed in the Student and Curriculum Handbooks. Questions regarding testing and course requirements for graduation should be referred to the school counseling staff.
